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The 2018 Conjurer was aged for 11 months in 25% new French oak, and has dark, brooding aromas of plums and Christmas spices, along with an herbal lift on the back end. The wine is richly textured, with an incredibly plush, soft entry that leads to an explosion of flavors on the palate. The palate is dominated by plums, black cherries, and earthy, savory elements like olives, which all lead to a beautifully long finish. The acid profile is tucked away behind the core of gorgeous fruit. Enjoy this beauty (with friends, of course) for the next 12-15 years.

"The 2018 Conjurer Red Blend checks in as 40% Cabernet Sauvignon, 35% Cabernet Franc, 24% Merlot, and a splash of Petit Verdot. Medium-bodied, elegant, and beautifully polished, it shows the more classic, straight style of the estate, is impeccably balanced, and is just a terrific Bordeaux blend to enjoy over the coming 7-8 years."
